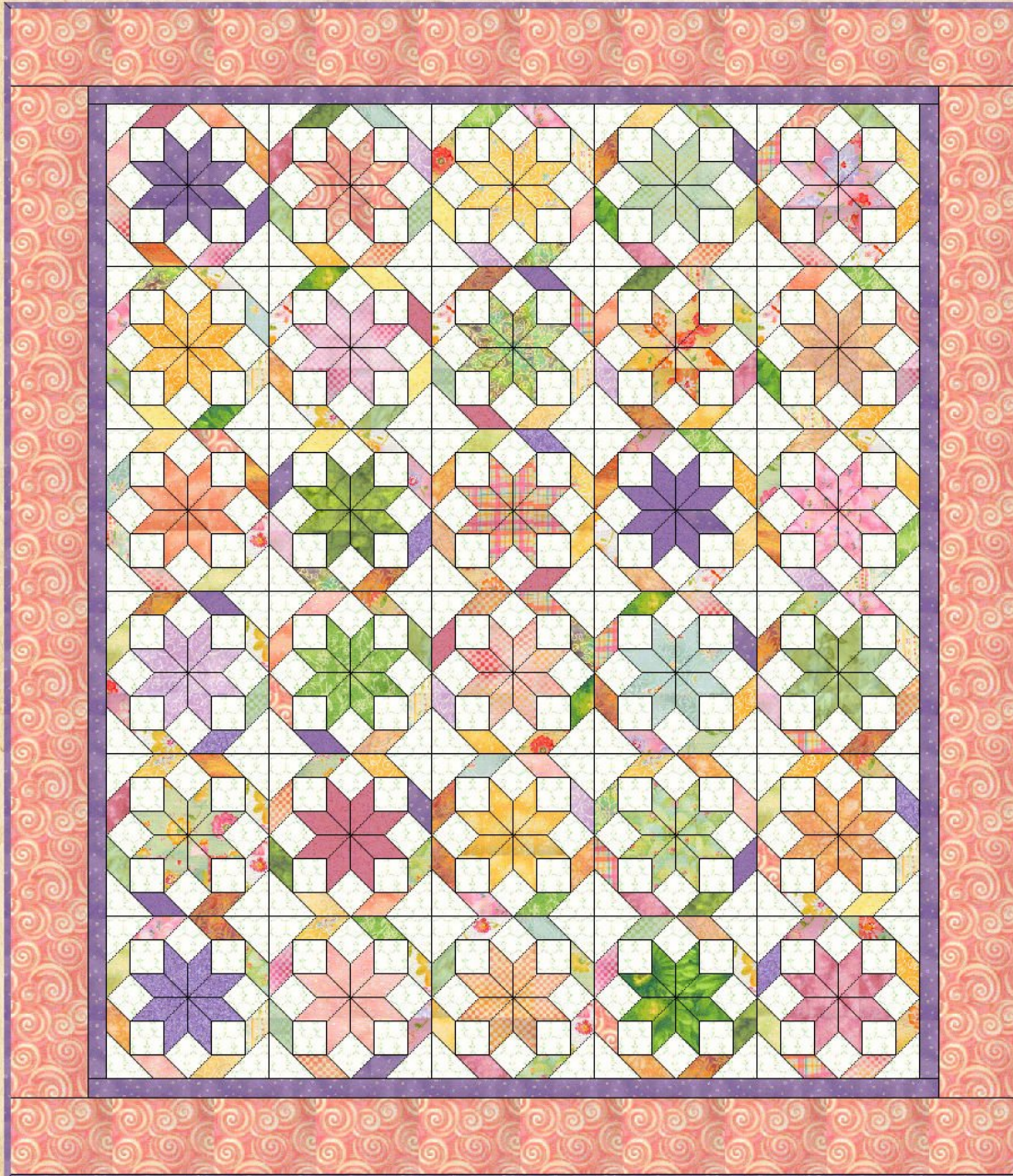

A Free Inklíngo Pattern

Can you tell I enjoy making blocks that use 8 pointed stars? (Tee Hee) Please note I haven't completely finished up my sample yet. This lap quilt can be made by adding additional yardage to a 10" x 10" "Layer Cake" with 40 pieces in it. However, you do not have to use a "Layer Cake." You can add the same yardage to 40 different 8.5" x 9" scraps and have enough to complete this quilt top.

Each block requires:

16 diamonds

8 diamonds of one fabric for center star

8 diamonds of multiple fabrics to go around the star

8 squares of your background fabric

4 half square triangles of your background fabric

Printing Chart:

As you are printing and cutting your diamonds, set aside 30 sets of 8 matching diamonds for the center stars in your blocks. Use the remaining diamonds randomly around your center stars. Sew the Rolling Star blocks together using your favorite method. They can be sewn by hand or machine or a combination of both. See pages 12 through 15 of the 6" LeMoyne Star Collection for instructions and sewing tips. Refer to picture of block on page 2 of pattern for placement of shapes.

After all your blocks are assembled, sew them together into 6 rows of 5 blocks. Sew your rows together.

The 1.5" Border 1 strips are probably just short of fitting the sides of your top. You will need to cut 2 of your strips in half. Sew 1 of your 4 halves onto the remaining 1.5" Border 1 strips to make them long enough to fit the sides and top of your quilt center. Add 1.5" Border 1 strips to the sides and then to the top and bottom. Repeat this process with the 4.5" Border 2 strips.

Layer your quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.

Use the 6- 2.5" strips to make your binding and bind your quilt. Don't forget your label!
