A Free Pattern for Inklingoists

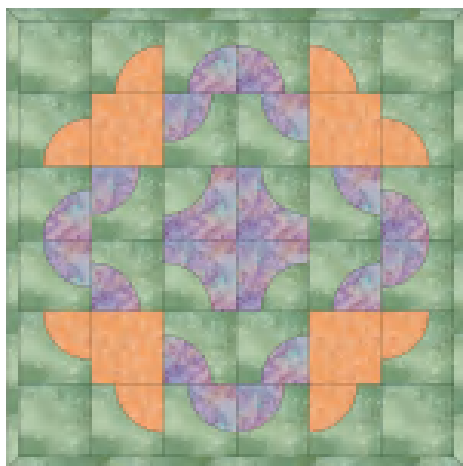
Uses the Drunkard's Path Collection  
Makes an 18" x 18" Butterfly in the Garden Block

Designed by Erin Klein

This pattern makes an 18" x 18" version of the Butterfly in the Garden block. Finish off the block with binding and use it as a wall hanging or table topper. Or add 8 more blocks and some border fabric for a 60" x 60" lap quilt. Yardage and printing layouts are given for both.

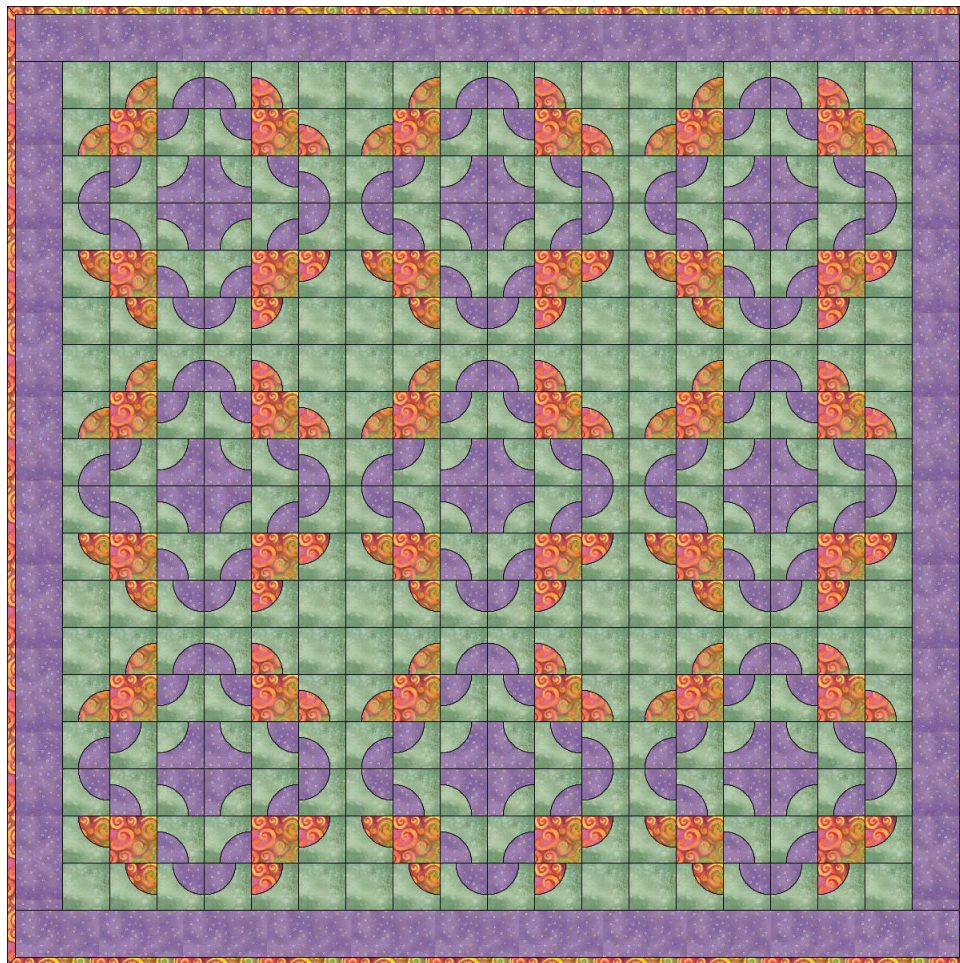
**Each 18" x 18" block requires:**

- 24 Shape A of Color 1
- 4 Shape B (quarter circles) of Color 1
- 4 Squares of Color 1
  
- 8 Shape B (quarter circles) of Color 2
- 4 Squares of Color 2
  
- 16 Shape B (quarter circles) of Color 3
- 1 Shape C (center) of Color 3

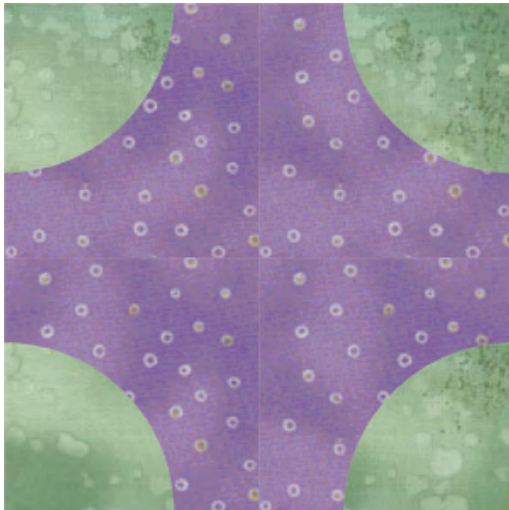

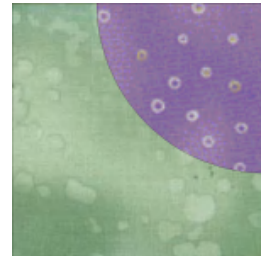

Refer to the picture of the Butterfly in the Garden block for shape placement. Refer to page 9 of the Drunkard's Path Collection for hand and machine sewing tips for the curved shapes. Drunkard's Path shapes can be hand pieced, machine pieced or a mixture of both.

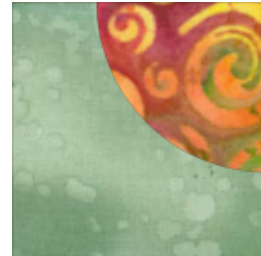
1. Sew the curved pieces together first.



You will have 1 of these for each block.

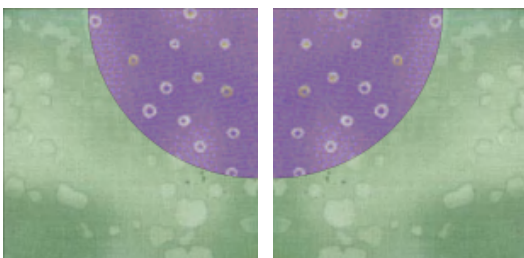
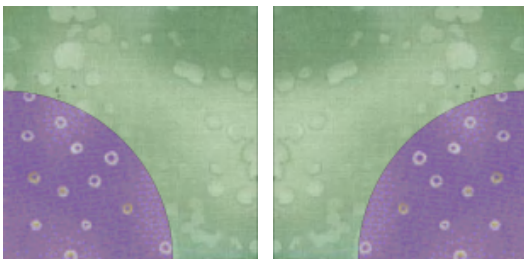


You will have 16 of these for each block.

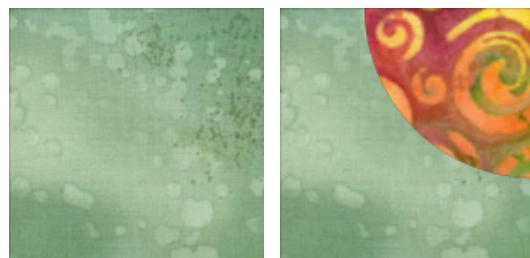
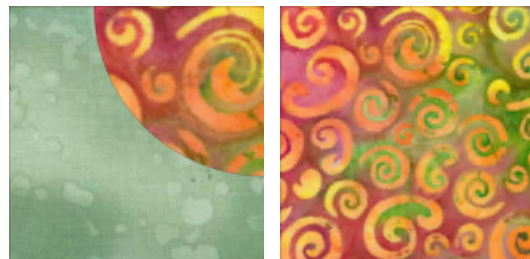


You will have 8 of these for each block.

2. Sew the curved sets together into mini blocks of 4 as shown.



You will have 4 of these for each block.

3. Sew the sets together as shown.



4. If you are making the wall hanging or table topper, skip down to Step 6. If you are making a quilt top, continue sewing until you have 9 blocks completed. Sew the 9 blocks together into 3 rows of 3 blocks.

5. Cut 2 of the 3.5" strips in half and sew 1 length to each of the remaining 4 strips to make the border. Sew the side borders to the quilt center and then the top and bottom borders.

6. Layer your quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Use the 2.5" strips to make your binding and bind your quilt. Don't forget your label!
